RE: Cancellation of Scheduled League games

It has been brought forth to the executive that there have been a few occasions where teams have cancelled games due to a limited number of players. The H1N1 situation has made us all aware how important it is that our players, coaches, etc. remain at home if they are sick or if they have an injury.

This along with shortages of available ice times at many of our arenas can make completing the league schedule difficult. That is why we are encouraging all teams to play their scheduled games even if they have a limited number of skaters.

We recognize that missing some players due to illness/injury can impact the outcome of the game more than others; but that should not be a reason to cancel a game on short notice.

Should you need to cancel or re-schedule please be reminded that the Constitution states the following – Under League Games: Item #5:

"If the game is postponed for reasons other than the weather, the team must notify the other team at least 24 hours before the start of the game."
