I have received several phone calls in regards to the home ice advantage during the playoffs. In all categories, home ice goes to the highest ranking team in the standings throughout the regular season. However, in the finals, the constitution states:

4. Playoff structure to be home and home best-of three (3). Semi-final: 1 vs. 4, 2 vs. 3. Top team in each group gets extra game. Home ice advantage will not apply for finals. In even years, West or North gets home game, and in odd years the East or South gets home game. Goes by what year it is during playoffs, not the start of the season. In the event there is only one division the team with the highest ranking after the regular season will have home ice advantage throughout the playoffs including the finals. Semi-final and final will be best-of three (3).

To clarify, in these 2010 playoffs, during the finals only, home ice will go to the West or North unless you only have one division and the highest ranking team will always play the lowest ranked team throughout the playoffs.
