The playoffs are becoming a little clearer, however, there are still some game sheets that need to come in to clarify playoff match-ups. Please ensure that your coaches and managers have faxed all game sheets in to the statistician. If you still have games to play please fax those game sheets immediately following the game.

In response to some questions about ties and determining league standings, the executive has decided to use the following scenario:

- 1<sup>st</sup> The team with the better win/loss record between the two teams.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> The team with the better goal percentage (MAHA rule 65c) between the two teams.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> The team with the most wins in the league competition.
- 4<sup>th</sup> If still tied, the executive will use a coin toss to determine the standings.

We do realize that it is not in the constitution, but with so many divisions having an unbalanced schedule, this is the only way to break ties regardless of the type of schedule. *(And believe me when I say that we will be discussing this at the spring meeting to get it in writing!)*

As discussed at the fall meeting, if you know the playoff matchup for sure without a doubt, then by all means you may start early. Please be sure to let me know so we can plan for the presentation of the banners.
